



Advice on writing a Nomination for a Girlguiding Award application

- Try to have a variety of referees
- You will need the nominee's full name and membership number
- In what capacity and for how long has the nominee been known to you
- Have you described their personal attributes and what makes them stand out from other leaders?
- Try to give examples that help to build a picture of their special character and personality
- Give examples of Guiding service and outstanding achievements
- Describe how their behaviour has influenced others
- Describe any special projects or events where your nominee has made an outstanding contribution and explain the impact on GUIDING
- We must also have a print out of the persons GO! history. If the nominee is under 17 years of age the Commissioner would need to contact membership support at CHQ to acquire a copy of their GO! history
- If applying for a GUIDING STAR award it would help to have information from the GP/ hospital or ward that the young person is with; this would only be used by the medical representative on the national committee
